

The upper or lower part of screens may be omitted in screen illustrations shown in this manual. Also, font or indications may be different from those on the actual screen or may be partly omitted.

Manners for Using Mobile Phones

- A mobile phone always generates weak electric waves while its power is ON.
- Be considerate of others and the environment around you, and have fun using your mobile phone safely.
 - There are places where the use of mobile phones is prohibited.
 - Do not use mobile phones while you are driving. Doing so is dangerous and also forbidden by law.
 - Be sure to turn your mobile phone OFF before you board airplanes.
 The use of cell phones onboard airplanes is forbidden by law.



- Electric waves from mobile phones may adversely influence medical devices and equipment.
 - People with a pacemaker may be close to you in crowded places such as trains. Turn your mobile phone OFF in such places.
 - Abide by the instructions of hospitals and other medical institutions where it is forbidden to use or carry mobile phones.



- Consider where to use your mobile phone and be careful of how loudly you talk.
 - Do not make calls from cinemas, theaters, museums, libraries and other similar places. Turn your mobile phone OFF or set it to the manner mode to prevent others around you from being inconvenienced by ring tones for incoming calls or mail.



- When on a crowded street, use your mobile phone in places where you do not prevent others from passing.
- When on a train or in a hotel lobby, move to areas where you will not bother others around you.
- Take care not to talk too loudly during conversations.





 Get permission from persons who will appear in photographs or movies before you take photographs or record movies of others with your mobile phone.


Useful Manner Mode and Answer Phone

■ Manner Mode

Use this mode to turn the ringer off to avoid annoying people around you.

Press and hold PUT/77- for more than one second in the Standby Screen.





Answer Phone

The caller can leave a message when you cannot answer the phone.

Turn Answer Phone ON.





Check the Power, Reception and Battery

■ Keep the "power" ON for normal use.

Keep the power ON to make or answer calls.

Press and hold for more than one second.






You cannot talk on the phone if the "electric waves" are too weak.

It is sometimes difficult to receive electric waves in some places even within a service area.

indicates the reception state.





Pay attention to the remaining "battery" power.

If the remaining battery power is too low, you may not be able to use the phone properly.

indicates the remaining battery power.






Beware of Junk Mail and One-Ring Calls!

If you receive junk mail...

Using the mail filter function, you can reject mail sent from specific addresses or mail that bears "未承 諾広告※(Unsolicited Ad mail)" in the title, which is the biggest source of junk mail.

The following mail functions are available for preventing arrival of junk mail.



- "未承諾広告フィルター": Rejects 未承諾広告 (Unsolicited Ad) mail.
- "アドレスフィルター": Rejects mail sent from specified addresses.
 - "指定受信設定": Accepts only mails sent from specified addresses.
 - "指定拒否設定": Rejects mails sent from specified addresses.



If you receive a call from an unknown number...

It may be a "One Ring Call" intended to trick you into calling back and accessing unwanted pay programs. If a one-ring call is received, is displayed in the received record.



How to Rotate the Display

In addition to being used in the normal open position, the W21SA can be used in the closed position with the Front Style (Phone closed with the display facing outward) or in the open position with the Recording Oneself Style (the display facing outward).








- This Basic Manual explains how to operate the W21SA when in the open position.
- Do not force the display to rotate it. Rough handling may damage the products.

Names of Parts





Charging the Battery Pack

The battery pack is not fully charged at the time of purchase.

Charge the battery pack with the dedicated charger before using the W21SA for the first time or after a long break.

■ How to Charge the Battery Pack

Connect the SANYO AC Adapter 03 to the Desktop Holder.




Check the pin configuration and orientation of the connector before connecting the adapter.

Plug the power plug of the SANYO AC Adapter 03 into an AC outlet.

Attach the W21SA in which the battery pack is installed to the Desktop Holder.



To detach, hold down the Desktop Holder and detach the W21SA.



- Incoming illuminator stays lit (red). → Charging in progress
- The light goes off. → Charging completed



The battery pack can also be charged by directly inserting the SANYO AC Adapter 03 connector into the external connection terminal on the W21SA phone.




Extending the Antenna

Hold the tip of the antenna and pull out until it stops.



- If the antenna is not extended far enough, it loses sensitivity and may fail to pick up signals sufficiently.
- When retracting the antenna, hold the lower part of the antenna and push straight down (1), then hold the upper part of the antenna and push straight down (2). Attempting to retract the antenna by force while holding the upper part may result in damage.
- Do not touch the antenna or entangle it in a metal strap, as these actions may result in weak electric waves.



Inserting/Removing the miniSD Memory Card (Commercially available)

Inserting

- ① Open the miniSD Memory Card Slot cover.
- 2 Insert the miniSD Memory Card into the miniSD Memory Card Slot until it locks in place, then close the cover.
- * Check which way the miniSD Memory Card is facing before inserting it into the slot.



Removing

- (1) Open the miniSD Memory Card Slot cover.
- 2 Slightly push the miniSD Memory Card inward to release the lock.
- 3 The miniSD Memory Card will come out. Pull it out slowly and close the cover.





If you flick the miniSD Memory Card inward with your fingernail, the miniSD Memory Card may pop out suddenly. Be careful not to direct it toward someone's face.

Turning the Power ON/OFF



Press and hold PWR for more than one second.



When the power is turned ON, the au logo is displayed and the Standby Screen appears.


Using the Main Menu

Pressing ((((Isin Menu)) while the standby screen is displayed displays the main menu. Use the cursor keys (() to select an item from the main menu, then press the center key () to enter and access the selected function.



How to Use the Launcher Menu

With the W21SA, the launcher menu can be conveniently used to access service menus for Mail, EZchannel, EZmovie, EZweb and EZnaviwalk.



Press while the launcher menu is displayed to select icons on the launcher menu. Use to select a service icon, then press ([Select]) to enter and access the selected service menu.



Press pure to return to the previous screen if you get confused or make a wrong operation. Press pure to return to the standby screen.

Operation with the Front Style (Phone closed with the display facing outward)

When using the phone in the Front Style (Phone closed with the display facing outward), use the side keys to operate it.

 Some functions such as the dial keys (for inputting telephone numbers and text) cannot be used.




How to Use the TURN MENU

Pressing the side center key () while using the phone in the Front Style (Phone closed with the display facing outward) and the standby screen displayed displays the TURN MENU.

Functions appearing in the TURN MENU can be accessed by selecting an item with the side cursor up and down keys (\P , and entering the selected function with the side center key (\square).

Perform initialization before using the E-mail and EZweb services. Initialization automatically provides your E-mail address. To change that E-mail address to a preferred address, see page 40.



Confirming Your Phone Number and E-mail Address

Press (MainManu) while the standby screen is displayed.





The main menu appears.

 - The Profile screen appears where you can confirm your phone number and F-mail address.







While the standby screen is displayed, your phone number and E-mail address can also be confirmed by pressing (((Linker)) and then Open.



How to Use the Phone



Making Calls

Use the Obehing - 9wxyz b keys to enter the receiver's phone number, then press .







Press PWR to hang up.

Making a call to a landline telephone, enter the phone number starting with the area code.

How to Make a Call

Add "184" before the phone number: Your phone number is not displayed on the receiver's end.

Add "186" before the phone number: Your phone number is displayed on the receiver's end.

Add nothing: The call is made in accordance with the Number Notice (Caller ID display) setting.



Press (Select), use to select "Add" and then press (OK) to add "184" or "186".

Answering Calls

Press during an incoming call to answer it.



Press PWR to hang up.

Screen Displays for Incoming Phone Calls

Caller's phone number	The caller has set it so as to display his/her phone number. The caller's name is
Example: "0900002XXXX"	also displayed if the caller's information is registered in your Address Book.
"ID Unsent"	The caller has set it so as not to display his/her phone number.
"Payphone"	The call is made from a payphone.
"Not Support"	The call is made from a phone that does not support ID notification.

Screen Display if the Call Is Not Answered

The message shows that there incoming calls were unanswered (Missed calls).

Press and use to select , and then press (confirm) on that screen to confirm the caller's phone number and call that number back. See page 23.



Calling Back (Outgoing Calls/Incoming Calls)

The list shows the most recent dialed/received call on the top.



Meanings of the icons displayed in the received records are as follows







Incoming Calls

Countermeasure for One-Ring Calls

■ What Are One-Ring Calls?

One-Ring Calls is a trick used to milk money from cell phone users. The call is hung up after only 1 ring so as to be left in the Incoming Calls history. Receivers who call back will access programs for which they must pay.

■ Icon as a Countermeasure for One-Ring Calls

With the W21SA, one-ring calls (ringer time is within 3 seconds) are indicated by in the Incoming Calls history. Be careful if you are not familiar with any phone numbers that are indicated this way.



Changing Ringer Type

Press (MainManu) while the standby screen is displayed.







Use to select "Basic Settings" and press (Select).

The Basic Settings screen appears.





- Use to select "Sounds/ Vibes" and press
 - The Sounds/Vibes setting screen appears.





- Use to select "Incoming Setup" and press (Select).
 - The Incoming Setup screen appears.





Use to select "Call Notice" and press



► The Call Notice setting screen appears.

Pressing [] (Preview) plays back the selected ringer.





The Call Notice selection screen appears.







"Original": Selects the ringer that was registered at the time

of purchase.

"Data Folder": Selects a ringer that was downloaded via EZweb.

"Search from EZweb": Connects to EZweb so that you can download new

ringers.



Adjusting Ringer Volume

 - The Call Notice Volume setting screen appears.





- Juse to adjust volume and press ((Set)).
 - Press on to increase the volume.
 - Press (to decrease the volume.





- There are 5 ringer volume levels plus "OFF" with which no ringer sounds. Press ((STEP)) to gradually raise the volume from level 1.
 - Press ((STEPL) to gradually lower the volume from level 5.
- Press (Define).





Use 🕥 to also change the ringer volume during an incoming call.

Adjusting the Other Party's Voice Volume

Use 🕲 to adjust volume during a call.

Press o to increase the volume.

Press to decrease the volume.

The voice volume can be adjusted in 9 levels during the call.





Setting the Manner Mode

The W21SA notifies you of the incoming call by vibrating.

Press and hold [೨೮७/२४-] for more than one second while the standby screen is displayed.





- " " and " " appear on the screen.

 Answer Phone is turned ON at the same time and " " appears on the screen.
- **■** To Turn OFF the Manner Mode

Press and hold DIT/TT- for more than one second when the manner mode is ON.

" " and " " disappear when the manner mode turns OFF. Answer Phone is turned OFF at the same time, and " " disappears.



There are 4 different manner modes available with the W21SA.

Using Answer Phone

Press (MeinMenu) while the standby screen is displayed.





The main menu appears.

- Use to select "Memo Menu" and press (Select).
 - The Memo Menu screen appears.





- Use to select "Ans.Ph./



■ To Turn Answer Phone OFF

Select "OFF" in step 5 and press (Set).



- Answer Phone can hold about 20 seconds of recorded message. Between it and Rec.Phone Memo, 3 messages can be recorded.
- Even when Answer Phone is turned OFF, a caller's message can be recorded by pressing and holding down (() for one second or more during the call. (This action does not turn Answer Phone ON.)
- Use Voice Mail when you have turned off the power or where electric waves are blocked.
- When a message is recorded from a caller, " [29] " is displayed over the number of unheard messages. Also, the color of " [29] " changes when 3 messages have been recorded.

Playing Back/Erasing Messages on Answer Phone

When a message is recorded on Answer Phone:

"New Notice Found" appears on the standby screen, therefore press .



Use to select " " and press ((Confirm)).

The Play AnsPh./Ph.Memo selection screen appears.



🔼: Unheard Answer Phone messages

: Heard Answer Phone messages





Use to select the recorded message to play back and press ((Play).

The recorded message is played back.







Pressing () () stops playback of the Answer Phone message.

■ To Erase a message on Answer Phone

Perform steps 1 ~ 3 on page 28 to display the Ans.Ph./ Ph.Memo setting screen.



Use to select "Play AnsPh/PhMemo" and press (Select).





Juse to select the recorded message to delete and press ([Menu).





Use to select "Erase" and press (OK).





Use ♦ to select "Erase One" and press ♦ (□K).





- A confirmation message appears asking whether to delete the message or not.
- Use to select "YES" and press (OK).



The selected Answer Phone message is deleted.

The receiver's phone number can be automatically dialed and a call easily placed by saving frequently called phone numbers in the address book.

Other Features

The W21SA is provided with other useful features.

Front Style (Phone closed with the display facing outward

Even when closed, you can check Mail and view information sites on the main display.

Character Reader (OCR)

You can register and create telephone numbers and E-mail addresses by scanning them with the camera. And, you can translate scanned text as well.

Full-fledged Mailing Features

Among various fun features, "Pastel Mail" enables you to send/receive vivid mail messages with a colored background and/or colored/blinking characters. With "Chara Moji Mail", you can convert the body of your message into images by downloading figure characters, and send the message as an attachment file even to third-party mobile phones.

Powerful Dictionary Features

English-Japanese, Japanese-English and katakana English term dictionaries are installed in the phone. These dictionaries can be very useful as you can also translate English into Japanese and vice-versa while entering characters.

Dictionary Downloads

It is possible to download dictionaries from "SANYO ケータイプラネット" and use information therein as conversion candidates when entering characters.

Pocket Light

The W21SA can be used as flashlight to light up outdoor garages, campgrounds or the keyhole at the entrance of your house at night.

Furthermore, registering with DPOF Print Reservation is useful when printing multiple photos and using DPE shops.

IC Recorder

The W21SA can record up to 8 hours of audio.

Simple Compass

It is possible to display one's bearings.

Photo Mixer

Used for adding messages to still images (photos) taken or downloaded, so to easily create photo animation. The photo animation you create can be attached to E-mail.

"Chaku-Uta (TM)" Support (Ringer)

A segment of an artist's singing voice can be downloaded to be used as the ringer or just for playback.

Mass Storage Mode

By connecting the attached USB Cable WIN (sold separately) to a personal computer, it is possible to use the miniSD memory Card provided with the W21SA just like a floppy disk. It is very useful as it makes it easier to exchange data with personal computers.

2-Dimensional Code Reader (EZappli (BREW™))

By recording 2-dimensional code (QR code) with the W21SA, it is possible to read QR-coded characters. The read information can be used for the address book or Mails.

※ QR (Quick Response) code is a 2-dimensional code of higher informational capabilities than barcodes.
